UNIFORM 1 Field Uniform (Class A) ➤ (shirt/pants/belt/socks/neckerchief) 1 Hiking boots (not sneakers)

	➤ (not just a poncho)
1	Swim towel
1	Bathing suit
1	First aid kit (personal kit)
1	Sunscreen (SPF 30+)
1	Hat / bandanna
1	Breakfast snack AND lunch
2	Water bottles

TRUNK

1	Sleeping bag / blanket / sheet
1	Floor mat
1	River shoes (closed toe) / old sneakers
	➤ NO water socks!
1	Long sleeve shirt (for warmth)
1	Long pants (no jeans or cotton)
1	Fleece or sweatshirt
1	Light weight jacket
2	Wool sox
1	Mess kit
1	Washcloth / [bath]towel
1	Insect netting
1	Scout / MB Handbook
1	Metal coat hanger
1	Spiral notebook & pencil/pen
1	Camp pillow
1	Hankerchiefs
1	Bathing suit (2nd set)
1	Swim towel (2nd set)

SMALL PLASTIC BOX (in TRUNK)	
1	Headlamp
	➤ with extra batteries
1	Totin' Chip
1	Firem'n Chit
1	Pocket knife* (must have Totin' Chip)
1	Matches* (must have Firem'n Chit)
1	6' rope w/carabineer
1	Mirror*
1	Cards / board games*
1	Clothes line (25')
4-6	Clothes pins
1	Disposable camera*

CLOTHING SETS IN BAGS (TRUNK)

7	T-shirts (Class B's or plain solid colored shirts)
7	Undergarmets
7-10	Socks
4-7	Shorts

TOILETRY KIT (TRUNK)

1	Toiletry bag
1	Toothbrush & toothpaste
1	Body soap (unscented)
1	Shampoo/conditioner (unscented)
1	Hairbrush / comb / hair accessories
1	Deoderant
1	Insect repellant (No DEET)

PACKED SEPARATELY

1	Insect netting poles
	➤ (unless using pop-up netting)
1	Sleeping pad
1	Carpet / tarp for tent floor

TURNED IN TO TROOP

	Spending money
1	Medications

NOTES:

- ➤ Please label ALL items!
- ➤ "*" denotes as Optional
- ➤ ALL medications MUST be managed by the camp or troop leadership. Refrigeration for meds is available as needed.
- ➤ Please **DO NOT** bring anything of significant value that might get lost or damaged!!

NOT ALLOWED IN CAMP

- Cell phones
- iPads / Tablet [computer] / PC's
- iPods / MP3 Players
- Portable DVD Players / CD Players
- Gameboy, etc...
- Anything with a "monitor / view screen"
 *Essentially, any electronic device(s)
- Food / Snacks / Candy or ANY kind
- Fireworks / Caps / Cap guns
- Fixed blades / flip-open knives
- Firearms / air guns
- Family heirlooms or anything you would be sorry to potentially lose or break
- Fighting / bullying and anything un-scout-like behavior

Troop 1029 has a ZERO tolerance policy for fighting.

without exception!
